He was also awarded Master of Public Health and Doctor of Medicine (Higher Medical Research Degree) from Chinese University of Hong Kong. His clinical speciality is Family Medicine with special interest in child and adolescent health, public health and health promotion. He has published over 160 articles in peer reviewed journals and over 100 invited presentations worldwide.
